

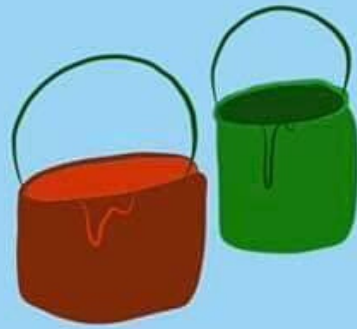
# HOW TO MAKE INKY TREES

MASKING TAPE

(KIDS PAINT/WATERCOLOUR  
OR INKS)



CARD OR A THICK  
PIECE OF PAPER

WATER



BLACK PEN OR CHARCOAL  
STICK



WIDE PAINT BRUSH OR  
SPONGE  
THIN PAINT BRUSH

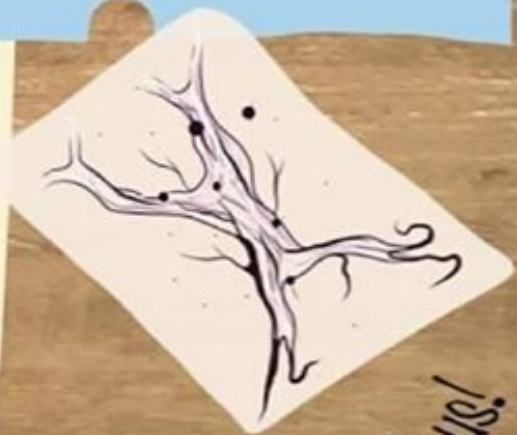

# How To Inky Trees



- Tape down your card or thick paper using masking tape or all four edges.
- Using a wide brush or sponge lightly dampen the whole surface area.
- Whilst damp begin. Drop your water based paint over your paper in a rough tree outline. Messy splats are good!
- Then using a small brush move the paint into loose lines, marking out your tree design.
- Add water to let the colours run and use a dry brush to keep distinctive lines.
- Once dry add detail and contrast using charcoal or a pen.
