Instruction 15: A hairdresser's/barber's shop

You will need:

- The other end of the box that you used yesterday for the village hall
- Thin card
- Recycled white paper
- Magazines to cut out and scissors
- Paints, brush and water
- Scissors

What to do:

1. Measure approximately 6cm away from one end round all four sides of the box and make a mark.
2. Cut along the marks to separate off the end of the box.
3. Mark out on the white paper the height of the building (6cm) and cut a strip long enough to go all round the box.
4. Fold the white paper round the box with the used side of the envelope facing inwards and make a crease at each corner.
5. Glue the white paper to the box and paint the walls of the shop.
6. Draw and colour in a door and a window.
7. Cut out from magazines small pictures of people who could look like customers.
8. Choose a name for the shop from a magazine and stick it on.
9. Find something that could look like a price-list and stick it on.

It might look a bit like this:
