

Rainbow Village by Amanda Jane Ogden

Instruction 20: The bus stop and bus shelter

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You will need:

- A clear thin plastic cup or recycled clear plastic carton
- Recycled grey, blue and white card
- Cardboard egg box
- Black felt pen
- Sticky tape
- Scissors

What to do:

1. Carefully cut round the cup 5cm up from the base.
2. Holding the bottom half of the cup, cut carefully down one side, across the base and up the other side (as if you were slicing it in half).
3. We will use one half today. Please keep the second half to use later in the project!
4. Put one half down on the blue card and draw round the shape.
5. Cut the shape (a semi-circle) out and glue it to the top of the bus shelter.
6. Glue the bus shelter in place by the road. Add sticky tape to help hold it in place.
7. Cut out one of the sections of the egg box. Trim it down to 1cm above the base.
8. Cut the egg box piece in half across the middle (like you did with the cup).
9. Glue the seat into the bus shelter.
10. Write a sign saying 'Bus Stop' in felt pen on a piece of card. Cut out a rectangle and fold it just above the letters.
11. Cut two supports from card, bend out the bottom sections in opposite directions and glue them together. Glue the sign on top. Glue the bus stop sign to the box, next to the shelter.

It might look a bit like this:
