Instruction 26: Trees

You will need:

- A white recycled envelope
- Pencil
- Recycled card
- Paints, paintbrush, water
- Scissors

What to do:

1. Use your ruler and pencil to draw a long strip about 10cm wide on the paper.
2. Fold the paper in half down the length.
3. Now fold the paper like a concertina so you end up with five or six double layers.
4. On the top layer use your pencil to draw a tree. At the top, don't draw a point, instead leave a flat line on the fold.
5. Draw sloping branches (maybe three on each side). On the sides, don't draw a point, instead leave a flat line on the fold.
6. With your scissors, cut out all the areas between your lines.
7. Then carefully open out the row of trees which should be joined together.
8. Paint them green.
9. Cut a piece of card with a fold in from packaging.
10. Glue the flat bit of the folded card under the flap of the cardboard box.
11. Glue the trees to the upright bit of the folded card.

It might look a bit like this:
