

Rainbow Village by Amanda Jane Ogden

Instruction 30: **The village sign** and gluing in the park benches

You will need:

- White and grey recycled card
- A recycled clear plastic cup or container
- Glue and spreader, sticky tape
- Pencil and felt pens

What to do:

1. Cut a rectangle about 4 x 6cm from white card.
2. Fold it in half, so you have a folded piece 4 x 3cm with a fold at the top.
3. Use the bottom of the cup (or another round object) to draw a half-circle in pencil.
4. Above the half-circle write the word 'Rainbow' using your rainbow colours:
5. red – orange – yellow – green – blue – indigo – violet
6. Then, using your rainbow colours, draw the lines of the rainbow going downwards from the half-circle you drew.
7. Take a black felt pen and write the word 'Village' across the rainbow.
8. Cut the plastic cup all round, about 5cm up from the base.
9. Cut it in half across the centre (as if you were slicing it in two).
10. Make two cuts down to the base, 1cm apart, in the middle of the curved side.
11. Cut away the extra plastic either side of the 1cm strip, but don't cut the base.
12. Glue and add sticky tape, to attach the base to the cardboard box, wherever you want your sign to go.
13. Glue the inside of the 'Rainbow Village' sign. Place it over the top of the plastic strip and press it tightly together.

It might look a bit like this:

Your village is complete! Well done.
